COVID protocols may include but are not limited to, completing an online confidential health attestation, wearing a face covering, and/or social distancing. Neighborhood House adapts protocols to meet current local and state recommendations, including those from Washington State Labor and Industries. Volunteers will receive a copy of current volunteer protocols prior to your event.
