Volunteer Needs

EVENT SET UP Help event organizers with activities related to event set up. Volunteers must be able to lift, squat, and carry 20 lbs.

Minimum Age: 16 Need: 7 – 10 people

EVENT SUPPORT Volunteers will help with a variety of tasks based on the needs of event organizers. You might welcome event attendees and help with registration, answering general event questions, food distribution, vendor support, and more! Volunteers may be asked to sit, stand, move between vendor booths, and carry supplies.

Bilingual volunteers encouraged, particularly those who speak Spanish, Somali, or Vietnamese, Pashtu, Farsi, Ukrainian, Oromo, Amharic.

Minimum Age: 16 Need: 5 - 8 people

EVENT CLEAN UP Help us leave our host sites a fresh and welcoming place to be by assisting with event clean up, including moving tables, chairs, and canopies. Volunteers must be able to lift, squat, and carry 20 lbs.

Minimum Age: 16

Need: 7 – 10 people.
