BACKGROUND AND PROGRAM SCOPE

- Ask screening questions about COVID.
- Ability to work with elementary aged school youth in a respectful and caring manner
- Take temperature of families coming to the site.
- Commit to 1-2 hours of service per week.
- Dependability and patience
- Helping minimize COVID exposure at sites.
- Help answer COVID related questions as the families ask.
