Applicant Disclosure of Potential or Actual Conflicts of Interest

As an applicant for employment at Neighborhood House, we ask that you let us know if you have any conflicts of interests. Examples of conflicts of interests could include:

- My brother works at Neighborhood House and might be the supervisor for a position I'm applying for.
- I previously worked for the Human Services Department at the City of Seattle and managed the contract with Neighborhood House.
- I own a business that sells goods or services to Neighborhood House.

A Conflict of Interest does not necessarily prevent you from taking a position with Neighborhood House. Many times the conflict can be accommodated. What's important is to disclose the conflict of interest.
