Neighborhood House has been providing high quality early childhood education programs for decades and was one of the first Head Start preschool providers in the Northwest region. Today we offer a full range of early-childhood education programs for low-income families – from expectant parents, to those with children birth to 5 years old. We focus on providing culturally appropriate services to all enrolled families, many of whom are recent refugees and immigrants. Volunteer Opportunity

This opportunity is dedicated to helping during story time. Our children love story time and volunteers love reading stories. This opportunity is done in two stages-first stage is helping with snack time, you will assist teachers give children their snacks and after clean up, the second stage is reading a story. You will choose which book to read-usually story time lasts 30-35 minutes. Afterwards the kids have free playtime or they go outside for recess.

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- Read with fun in your voice. Be expressive!
- Choose books with vivid pictures and make sure you show the children
- Introduce the book: point out the cover illustration, title, and author
- Our students represent many cultures and languages. If you have a favorite book or story in your language, please consider bringing that to share with our families.
